Minutes of the Last Meeting

The Minutes of the last Meeting dated 26th March 2018 was agreed, and signed off by the Chairman.

Matters Arising

Rob and Sue have organized one book shelf and filled it with paperback books, which looks great. Rob has agreed to make a couple more and an explanatory notice on how the book share works will be organized by Sue.

Rob Baker has completed the cutting down of the tree branches, and top of the tree. He will, when the weather permits, cut down the trunk to a suitable height, and commence carving a face and an owl on the top.

Brian has received interest for Puppy Training Classes. They are looking to hire the hall for 2 hours per week either on Tuesday or Saturday. They have agreed to thoroughly clean the hall after use.

Sue/Rob contacted Emma who runs a First Aid for Children – Little Life Savers – to see if there is any interest in hiring the Hall. She will consider when she has enough interest.

Val Smith Hardwood Board/Sign 4ft x 1.5ft, was taken to the Prison but is still waiting for completion of the engraving.

Windsor mentioned that the light in the disabled Toilet has started flashing again. Rob has already installed a new starter, so will purchase and install a new tube.

Brian confirmed that the application form for the Community Building Energy "Make Over" from Monmouthshire County Council has been completed and sent, but to date has not heard anything from them.

The Coffee morning on Tuesday 10th April 2018 - 11.00am to 1.00pm was a success. 25 People attended and donations came to £31.

Windsor requested a large box in which to store the Christmas Decorations. Rob will organize.

Further discussions took place on our Data Protection Policy, following the new GDPR on 25th May.

Roger will check that we are in compliance and if necessary include in the Newsletter. Kay will distribute a main pointer schedule to Annis & Roger.

Sue mentioned that there was a lot of information on beefriendlymonmouthshire.org. I have just printed out the rhs.org.uk/perfectforpollinators list of Garden Plants as well as Wildflowers, which details all the flowers and plants that flower and attract bees during the FOUR Seasons

Flowers, shrubs etc that are bee friendly will need to be acquired.

A request for supply of plants, as well as help planting will need to go in the Newsletter, to be completed by Roger.
